Competition Rules

- Competitions are run in accordance with FIS rules. Detailed rules are available at www.fisSKI.com
- Certified helmets are mandatory for all training and competitions.
- Each city may enter a maximum number of 4 girls and 4 boys and a minimum of 2.
- Children must be 12 by Jan. 1 the year of the Games and not turn 16 the year for the Games (Dec. 31)

There will be the following competitions:

- Alpine GS
- Ski Cross

Format

- Alpine Giant Slalom - Two runs best run score to be scored
- Ski Cross - One Timed run for seating into Heats. Heats will be used to determine final results

Technical Meeting

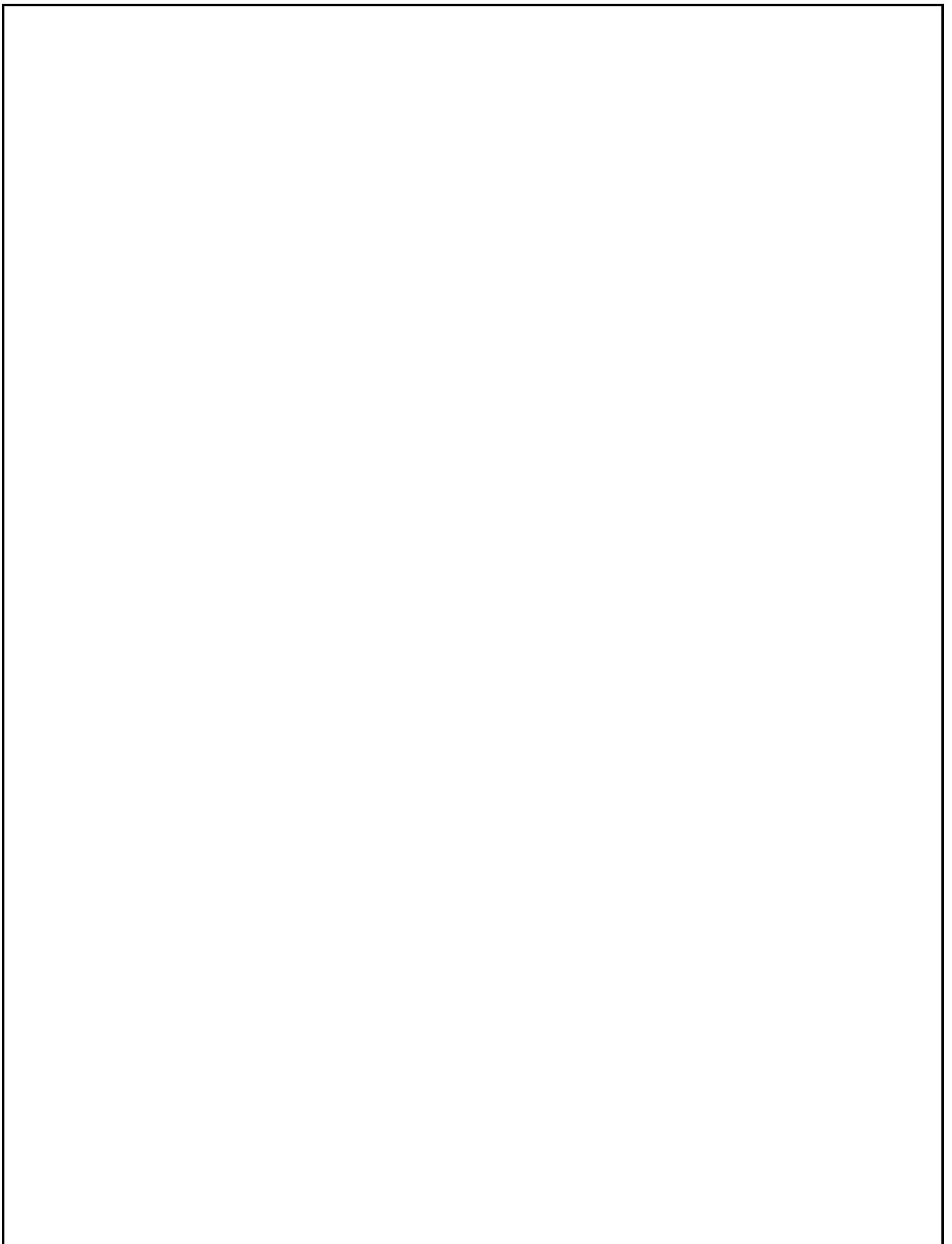
The Skiing Technical Meeting will be held on the evening of Jan 26, 2011. Time and Place TBD All coaches expected to attend.

- All Competitors must have their own equipment such as snowboards, boots, clothing, helmets etc.
